- 1M+/- residents
- 6th largest county by population
- 274 square miles
- 2nd smallest county by area
- Most densely populated county
- 24 municipalities
- Clearwater & St. Petersburg are largest cities
- Highest elevation = 110 ft above sea level
- Very little developable land (built out)


• Prior to 2009:

2009: BTS approached Esri about a <u>Partnership</u>

- Driving forces:
 - Two GISs created inefficiencies & barriers to collaboration & sharing
 - IT Consolidation
 - Unsupported web technology
 - Web GIS apps did not support modern browsers
 - Lack of modern mobile solutions (internal & external)
 - Loss of key staff
 - Unsustainable, custom, wanted to prioritize on COTS

- County creates Enterprise GIS Governance – (EGIS) Steering Committee







County's Smart Communities Approach Key to Win





Redlands, California—This week, Esri presented Pinellas County, Florida, with the 2016 Enterprise GIS Award for innovating a smart community governance model. That model fulfilled county initiatives to build a public GIS with apps that benefit the community. One of those apps used Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) open data to save property owners \$5.3 million on National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) premiums.





Pinellas County's Zoning / Land Use Unincorporated Lookup. This self-service application allows users to look up the zoning and land use information on county proprieties.



AIRS (AERIAL IMAGERY)

Pinellas County's Aerial Imagery Viewer. This application contains historic and current aerial imagery for the County.



CRIME VIEWER

Crime Viewer allows users to view crime data reported by the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office and other municipal police departments.




STORM SURGE

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


Membership and Guidelines


- Made up of executive leaders from various County stakeholder departments (Property Appraiser, Supervisor of Elections, Public Works, Utilities, etc.)
- Subject to public record and sunshine laws
- Decides project prioritization, funding, budget, organizational changes and strategic direction of Enterprise GIS program
- Enforces COTS over Custom
- Leaves project initiation to GIS Working Group made up of staff-level members (GIS Community)






Pinellas County System Architecture

Pinellas County's Approach

- Always deploy Commercial Off the Shelf when possible
- Adopted strategy by executive leadership written into Enterprise GIS governance
- Projects reviewed by management to ensure enforcement and sustainability
- Customization only when business value is greater than life-cycle cost of development
- An 85%-90% solution is acceptable to avoid long-term maintenance headaches



Strategic Planning

- Create a sustainable, attainable strategic plan with realistic goals and objectives
- Create a shared vision for what you want your organization to look like
- Target a 3 year time horizon
- Identify key issues that strategic plan will address for your organization
- Outline strategies to reach goals and address key issues
- Manage Change
